BENEFITS OF GREENBELT

For over 30 years, ExxonMobil has acquired land around the Baton Rouge Complex to preserve native Louisiana ecosystems.

The program improves aesthetics and quality of life in North Baton Rouge by reducing blight and expanding green space. Around 5,000 trees have been planted, creating habitat for wildlife including birds, bats, butterflies, and squirrels.



Monte Sano Bayou Cleanup

ExxonMobil has collaborated with the Louisiana Stormwater Coalition on an important environmental initiative: the **Monte Sano Bayou Litter Boom**. This litter boom was installed in July 2024 and has successfully collected nearly **1,000** pounds of litter since its implementation. Education and workforce development

As one of Baton Rouge's largest employers, ExxonMobil depends on a skilled local workforce. We invest in developing talent through training, competitive wages, and career opportunities.



High School Internship Program

ExxonMobil's paid High School Internship gives about 40 students hands-on experience in Engineering, Terminal and Lab Operations, IT, Projects, Pipeline, Environmental, and Contractor roles. In its third year, the 2024 program included onboarding, a STEM trip to LSU and the Water Institute, site visits with MMR and Turner Industries, mentoring, project presentations, team building, a visit from NBA player Damien Jones, and volunteering with the Food Bank and Habitat.

ExxonMobil maintains a robust partnership with Louisiana State University and Southern University, encompassing a wide variety of initiatives: campus recruiting, advisory board participation, strategic committees, and joint research initiatives. ExxonMobil also supports student development via sponsorships, scholarships, and other educational programs that promote innovation and academic excellence.



North Baton Rouge Industrial Training Initiative (NBRITI)

The North Baton Rouge Industrial Training Initiative (NBRITI) provides basic craft training in electrical, instrumentation, millwright, pipefitting, process technology and welding at no-cost to qualifying participants. Students learn through fast-tracked classroom and hands-on training. Graduates earn nationally recognized construction certifications from the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) and American Welding Society (AWS).


